

Trustee Vacancy Appointment Procedure

- 1. If the office of a Trustee becomes vacant, the remaining members of the Board shall, subject to the provisions of Part VII of the *Education Act*, hold a by-election or appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy.
- 2. If the Board of Trustees determines that the vacancy shall be filled by appointment, the appointee must be selected within ninety (90) days after the office became vacant.
- To fill a vacancy by appointment, the Board shall advertise the opening, the eligibility criteria, and the date by which interested candidates may submit a written application and any accompanying documents they deem relevant.
- 4. Each eligible applicant will be invited to make a five (5) minute presentation at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- 5. The order of presentation will be determined by each candidate drawing a number.
- 6. Following the presentations, the Board of Trustees may resolve to dissolve the public meeting and meet *in camera* to discuss the candidates' applications.
- 7. Selection of the appointee shall be determined by ballot at a public meeting of the Board of Trustees, in accordance with the following procedure:
 - a. All candidates who submitted an application and made a presentation to the Board of Trustees shall be eligible for appointment;
 - b. The Presiding Officer will appoint two returning officers to act as scrutineers for the vote;
 - c. The successful candidate must receive a majority of the votes cast;
 - d. If after the initial vote no one candidate has received a majority of the votes cast, the process shall be repeated, provided that any candidate who did not receive any votes shall be eliminated;
 - e. If after a second round no one candidate has received a majority of the votes cast, a third and if necessary further subsequent voting rounds will be held, in each instance eliminating any candidates who did not receive any votes, or if

- all candidates received one or more votes, eliminating the candidate(s) with the fewest votes;
- f. If a tie results which cannot be broken by a vote, an appointee shall be chosen by drawing lots, where the candidate who draws the longest lot shall be appointed to fill the vacancy.
- 8. In each round of voting, after the ballots have been counted, both the vote count and how each trustee voted shall be announced by the Presiding Officer of the meeting.
- 9. The Presiding Officer will announce the name of the successful candidate, who shall hold the office for the remainder of the term of the member who vacated the office.
